**Action Research: ALL**

Area of Focus: Empower teachers with a data base of strong lessons to engage students

Collect Evidence: Ss engagement must be kept; Bbytes survey

Develop a plan: THIS MOMENT! THIS PLAN

Implement, plan, collect, & analyze data: Track usage, track uploads, track comments

Communicate Results: Digital Platform, The Holler, Track Hits/Uploads/Usage

Continue Reflection & Plan for new cycle: Allow comments (think Facebook), Allow uploads, constant uploads & reflections – cycle each time a lesson is used (think Yelp/TripAdvisor – but for the classroom)
